Alessandro Rivetto, Barbaresco, Piemonte, 2014

Alessandro Rivetto has been producing great wines since 1902. This beautiful Barbaresco has a dark cinnamon, blue flower and truffle aromas. The taut palate shows Morello cherry, cranberry and white pepper notes alongside firm acidity and somewhat grainy tannins.

Alessandro Rivetto, Langhe, Piemonte, Rosso, 2015

Predominantly Nebbiolo, this is a rare blend. Red fruit and cassis on the nose with some damp forest floor. Chalky high tannic mouthfeel with a super juicy and long lingering finish. Excellent concentration and full structured. This is a very good wine. High quality.
